STANDARD POLICY PROVISIONS

Unique Identification Number: 101N078V01

1. General

Your Policy is a Regular Premium with profit plan. Being a with profit plan, your policy will participate in the profits of the Participating Policyholders Fund of HDFC Standard Life Insurance Company Limited and, providing premiums continue to be paid for the entire policy term, reversionary and interim bonus, as applicable, will be added to your Policy.

The bonuses will accrue and will be added to the policy only after it acquires a Guaranteed Surrender Value i.e. no reversionary bonus will accrue or be paid for the first two years of the policy.

The reversionary bonus rate declared by the company is guaranteed to be a minimum of 3% p.a. up until 31 March 2021.

Where applicable, a terminal bonus may also be added to your Policy. The terminal bonus is, however not guaranteed to be paid.

Where applicable, an enhanced terminal bonus will also be added to your Policy. The enhanced terminal bonus is, however not guaranteed to be paid.

We reserve the right to change any of these policy provisions if it becomes impossible or impractical to enact the provision.

2. Definitions

Company, Insurer, Us, We - means HDFC Standard Life Insurance Company Limited.

Due dates – means the dates at which Regular Premiums are due to be paid by you.

Policyholder, You - means the Policyholder stated in the Policy Schedule. The policyholder is the owner of the Policy.

Life Assured - The Life Assured is the person on whose life the contingent events has to occur for the benefits to be payable. The Life Assured may be the policyholder.

Expiry Date of Death Benefit – means the date on which the term of the Policy ends and is the date when the Death Benefit cover ceases.

Maturity Date – means the date on which the original term of policy ends and is the date when the risk cover ceases.

3. Benefits

If you pay all the premiums as and when due, we will pay the following benefits to you or to any other person who is entitled to receive them:

(i) Maturity Benefit

On survival of the Life Assured to the end of the policy term and on the payment of all premiums due under the policy, the maturity benefit will be paid. The maturity benefit will depend on the Maturity Benefit Option.

The policyholder may exercise the Maturity Benefit Option 30 to 180 days before the maturity date of the policy. If the policyholder does not choose the Maturity Benefit Option, the maturity benefit as described under the Enhanced Cash Option will be payable.

(a) If Enhanced Cash Option is chosen - the Maturity Benefit payable is the Sum Assured as stated against 'Maturity Benefit' in the Schedule of Benefits, plus attaching reversionary bonuses plus any interim and terminal bonus applicable. In addition to this amount, an enhanced terminal bonus will also be payable.

Upon this payment the policy terminates and no further benefits will be payable. The additional sum assured payable under Enhanced Cover Option will not be payable.

(b) If Enhanced Cover Option is chosen - the Maturity Benefit payable is the Sum Assured as stated against 'Maturity Benefit' in the Schedule of Benefits, plus attaching reversionary bonuses, plus any interim and terminal bonus applicable. In addition to this amount, an additional Sum Assured will be payable on death of the Life Assured up to age 99 years.

Upon this payment the policy terminates and no further benefits will be payable. The enhanced terminal bonus payable under Enhanced Cash Option will not be payable.

In the event the policy has acquired paid-up status, the sum assured reduces as specified in Provision 6(i). The maturity benefit payable for a paid-up policy is paid-up sum assured plus the reversionary bonus attaching to the date the policy is made paid-up. A paid-up policy will not be eligible to choose the Maturity Benefit Option.

Upon this payment the policy terminates and no further benefits will be payable. No future reversionary bonuses, no terminal bonus, no enhanced terminal bonus payable under Enhanced Cash Option and no additional sum assured payable under Enhanced Cover Option will be payable.

(ii) Death Benefit

On a valid death claim of the Life Assured before the Expiry Date of this Benefit, the Sum Assured as stated against 'Death Benefit' in the Schedule of Benefits, plus any attaching reversionary bonuses, plus interim and terminal bonus (if any) applicable at the date of death is payable, subject to Provision 9 (Exclusions).

In case the death is due to an accident, then an additional sum assured as stated against 'Accidental Death Benefit' in the Schedule of Benefits will become payable, subject to Provision 9 (Exclusions).

Upon this payment the Policy terminates and no further benefits are payable.

In the event the policy has acquired paid-up status, the sum assured reduces as specified in Provision 6(i). On a valid claim, the benefit payable for a paid-up policy is paid-up sum assured plus the reversionary bonus attaching to the date the policy is made paid-up.

Upon this payment the Policy terminates and no further benefits are payable.

- (iii) The level of sum assured cannot be increased or decreased by the policyholder anytime during the policy term.
- (iv) The premium paying term cannot be increased or decreased anytime during the policy term.
- (v) The Policy Term cannot be increased or decreased anytime during of the entire duration of the policy term.

Pre-requisites for payment of benefits:

Before we pay the benefit under your Policy we will require to be satisfied that:

- (i) the policy has not been surrendered, terminated or cancelled;
- (ii) the information that were given in the application are correct; and
- (iii) all Policy provisions including any endorsement to your Policy have been met: and
- (iv) the person to whom the benefits are to be paid is entitled to receive them;

and in addition:

Maturity Benefit

We will pay the maturity benefit only if the policy has not been surrendered or cancelled or terminated; and no claim has been made on the Policy and we are satisfied that the Policy has matured and the Life Assured is surviving to the Maturity Date; and all relevant documents in support of the claim have been provided. These would normally include the original Policy document.

Death Benefit:

We will pay the death benefit only if the policy has not been surrendered or cancelled or terminated; and we are satisfied that the death of the Life Assured has occurred before the expiry date of this benefit; and the standard policy provisions specified in Provision 9 (Exclusion) and Provision 10 (Incorrect Information and Non Disclosure) are not

attracted; and all relevant documents in support of the claim have been provided. These would normally include the fully completed claim form, and original Policy document, and original or certified copy death registration certificate, and original or certified copy of certificate of doctor certifying death, and original or certified copy of certificate of cremation or burial, and originals or certified copy of any medical reports that we consider relevant to the death. Depending on the circumstances of the death further documents as we might reasonably require may need to be provided.

We will pay the additional sum assured on accidental death only if we are further satisfied that the death of the Life Assured was attributable to an accident; and the Life Assured dies within 90 days of the accident and before the expiry date of the accidental death benefit; and the standard policy provisions specified in Provision 9 (Exclusion) and Provision 10 (Incorrect Information and Non Disclosure) are not attracted; and all relevant documents in support of your claim have been provided. In addition to the documents mentioned above, an accidental death claim would normally also require original First Information Report; and original Police Panchanama; and original Police Inquest report; and original post-mortem report; and originals or certified copies of any medical reports that we consider relevant to the death. Depending on the circumstances of the death, further documents may have to be provided as we might reasonably require.

4. Payment and cessation of premiums

- (i) The first premium must be paid along with the submission of your completed application. Subsequent premiums are due in full on the date(s) (called here the "Due Dates") and at the frequency set out in your Policy schedule. There will be a 15 day grace period after the Premium Due Date for the payment of each renewal premium after the initial premium. We will not accept part payment of the premium.
- (ii) If any premium remains unpaid 15 days after the Due Date, your Policy may Lapse or become Paid-Up, as described in Provision 6, with effect from the Due Date of the first unpaid premium.
- (iii) If premiums cease your Policy may acquire a surrender value, to be determined by us at our sole discretion.
- (iv) If, however, you pay premiums for a continuous period of 3 years, your Policy will acquire a guaranteed minimum surrender value, which will be calculated in accordance with Provision 5.
- (v) The frequency at which regular premiums are paid can be changed. If you have chosen Monthly premium payment frequency, you are required to pay the first 3 months premium along with the proposal form.
 - The premiums that are paid before the Due Date will be deemed to have been received on the Due Date for that Regular Premium respectively and no interest will be paid on such advance premiums.
- (vi) The Annualised Premium Level cannot be decreased or increased at any point of time except due to a change in premium paying frequency and only to that extent.

5. Guaranteed Minimum Surrender Value

If you pay premiums for a continuous period of 3 years, the guaranteed minimum surrender value of your Policy, including the value of any attaching bonuses, will be:

- Zero in respect of premiums paid in the first year; and
- 50% of premiums paid subsequent to the first year, excluding any extra premiums paid.

6. Lapsed Policies, Paid-Up policies and Reinstatement

(i) Lapsed and Paid-Up policies

If any Premium remains unpaid 15 days after the Due Date during the first 3 years of the Policy, the policy will be altered to lapsed status and no benefits would be payable.

In the event that any premium remains unpaid 15 days after the Due Date and your Policy has acquired a guaranteed surrender value, your Policy will be altered to a paid-up Policy, subject to any terms and conditions, which we may specify from time to time. These terms will involve a reduction in benefits and you will be informed accordingly.

Once your Policy is made paid-up it will cease to participate in profits and will not qualify for addition of any future bonus. Reversionary bonus attached to the policy on the date the policy is altered to paid-up status, will continue to be attached.

For a paid-up policy, the sum assured would reduce to paid-up sum assured. The paid-up sum assured will be sum assured multiplied by the ratio of the number of the premiums due and paid to the number of the premiums payable under the policy.

(ii) Reinstatement of Lapsed and Paid-Up policies

If your Policy has been paid-up or lapsed, it may be reinstated, subject to our consent and such terms and conditions as we may specify from time to time. The terms and conditions would include a minimum of providing satisfactory evidence of good health, payment of all outstanding premiums and interest on all outstanding premiums.

7. Loans

Subject to the prevailing taxation and applicable rules and regulations, your Policy provides the facility to avail a loan from us against this policy after it has acquired a guaranteed surrender value. Please note that this is a facility and not a right. Based on our internal appraisal process we reserve the right of refusal to grant a loan against your policy without stating any reason.

8. Assignments and Nominations

Any notice of assignment or change in nomination must be notified in writing to us at our Correspondence Address noted in your Policy schedule.

9. Exclusions:

- a) We shall not be liable to pay any benefit indicated in your Policy schedule other than the accrued surrender value, if any if the death of the Life Assured is caused directly or indirectly by suicide within one year of the Date of Commencement or the date of issue or date of reinstatement/revival of the Policy, whichever is later.
- b) We will not pay additional Sum Assured on accidental death, if death is caused directly or indirectly from any of the following:
 - Intentionally self-inflicted injury or suicide, irrespective of mental condition.
 - Alcohol or solvent abuse, or the taking of drugs except under the direction of a registered medical practitioner.
 - Taking part or practising for any hazardous hobby, pursuit or race unless previously agreed to by us in writing
 - War, invasion, hostilities (whether war is declared or not), civil war, rebellion, revolution or taking part in a riot or civil commotion.
 - Taking part in any flying activity, other than as a passenger in a commercially licensed aircraft.
 - Taking part in any act of a criminal nature.

10. Incorrect Information and Non-Disclosure

Your Policy is based on the application and declaration which you have made to us and other information provided by you/on your behalf. However, if any of the information provided is incomplete or incorrect, we reserve the right to vary the benefits, which may be payable and, further, if there has been non-disclosure of a material fact then we may treat your Policy as void from inception.

For your benefit, Section 45 of the Insurance Act, 1938 is reproduced below:

No policy of life insurance effected before the commencement of this Act shall after the expiry of two years from the date of commencement of this Act and no policy of life insurance effected after the coming into force of this Act shall, after the expiry of two years from the date on which it was effected, be called in question by an insurer on the ground that a statement made in the proposal for insurance or in any report of a medical officer, or referee, or friend of the insured, or in any other document leading to the issue of the policy, was inaccurate or false, unless the insurer shows that such statement was on a material matter or suppressed facts which it was material to disclose and that it was fraudulently made by the policy-holder and that the policy-holder knew at the time of making it that the statement was false or that it suppressed facts which it was material to disclose:

Provided that nothing in this section shall prevent the insurer from calling for proof of age at any time if he is entitled to do so, and no policy shall be deemed to be called in question merely because the terms of the policy are adjusted on subsequent proof that the age of the life insured was incorrectly stated in the proposal.

11. Service Tax

As per the service tax laws, service tax is applicable on life insurance premium. Any indirect tax or statutory levy becoming applicable in future may become payable by you by any method we deem appropriate including by levy of an additional monetary amount in addition to the premium.
